Dear Parent / Carer

Pupil Premium – individual funding for your child that could have a measurable impact on their education.

Winslow Church of England School receives a Pupil Premium Grant for each child who is entitled to receive Free School Meals or who has been entitled to over the last 6 years; and for any Looked After Children or Service Children. As with most schools, the bulk of this funding is allocated to additional support staff, enabling small groups, extra maths sets and intervention groups. It also allows our school to offer a range of extra provision, to all children who are eligible, to enhance their progress and learning opportunities. Universal Free School Meals in Foundations Stage 2, Year 1 and Year 2 is not linked to Pupil Premium.

In order to receive 'Pupil Premium' a parent/carer for any child in our school must be claiming one of the following benefits:

- Income Support
- Income-Related Employment and Support Allowance
- Income-Based Job Seekers Allowance (not contribution based)
- Child Tax Credit (but not if Working Tax Credit is being received or have an annual income in excess of £16,190 – this figure is for April 2018)
- The Guaranteed Element of the State Pension Credit
- Asylum Seeker under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- Universal Credit

Pupil Premium funding is also available to children for the following reasons:

- They have been adopted from care
- A Parent currently serving in the Regular Armed Forces or in the Armed Forces of another country stationed in England
