Open to all children in school, over three categories:

- Foundation Stage & Key Stage 1 (FS1, FS2, Yr.'s 1 & 2)
- Lower Key Stage 2 (Yr.'s 3 & 4)
- Upper Key Stage 2 (Yr.'s 5 & 6)

This is great opportunity for all children, with the added bonus of video cameras now being easily available on a variety of technology. We look forward to watching some great films.
