Dear Parents and Carers,

I am very pleased to be able to write to inform you that Mr Lawrence has been able to arrange for the circular playground to be fully resurfaced. I am sure that many of you have noticed the deterioration of the surface of this playground. A new surface will make it much more inviting and safer for our children to play on.

The work on the playground will commence on Monday 13<sup>th</sup> September. We are hopeful that the work will be completed within the week. Over the weekend fencing will be erected to ensure the safety of all children and adults while the work is completed. We have put some other measures in place to ensure the safety of children including playtimes and PE lessons away from this area.

Access to school will only be slightly affected for you at the beginning and end of day. All parents and children will still have access into and out of the school site via all three gates. If you enter via the front gate off Lowndes Way, there will be an access path between the construction fence and the Reception garden fence. If you enter via the gate off Magpie Way, adjacent to the circular playground, there will be a pathway across the grass for you to use and join the other playground. The Emfields gate access will not be affected at all.

During the works we would ask that you keep all children, both pupils and younger pre-school children away from the fence as much as possible. The trucks etc. may prove very interesting to some of them but please get them to watch at a distance. Please also keep children off of the main field beyond the playground as construction vehicles could be moving between the car park and the playground. Please supervise children when putting or collecting bikes and scooters in the bike shed.

Once completed the playground will have new markings also for the children to play on. The current climbing equipment situated on the playground will be removed but will be reinstated in due course on the grass next to the playground.

A reminder that parents should use the pathways at all times and not enter or exit via the car park on foot.
