To that end we are setting up **telephone appointments** for the following dates.

You are invited to book a ten minute telephone call on *one of two* Parents' Evenings that have been arranged for:

Tuesday 12th October 3.30pm – 6.00pm

&

Thursday 14th October 3.30pm – 6.00pm

When you book your appointment please enter the telephone number you would like teachers to call you on in the notes information section. Teachers will then phone you at your booked time. Please note calls will not be able to extend beyond 10 minutes but the classteacher will arrange further communication with you if this is needed.

This is an opportunity for you to talk with your child's classteacher/s and to discuss your child's first few weeks back in school and in their new class.

All Parent Evening appointments will be available to book online by parents via your ParentMail account. An email will be sent inviting you to parents evening and appointments will be available to book from 7.00am on Wednesday 29th September.

Please login to your ParentMail accounts main menu and select Parents Evening. Click on the link shown, then click your preferred date, which will then give you a selection of available times for you to choose from.

Online bookings will close on **Wednesday 6th October** to allow for the school office to process all appointments.
